Cheryl Ann Keatley Scholarship



Purpose

The purpose of this scholarship is to encourage postgraduate training in incontinence nursing by providing financial assistance to students undertaking the Graduate Certificate in Older Adult Care and Wellbeing.

Benefits

Subject to the availability of funds, there will be one scholarship valued at \$1,000 awarded annually.

Source of Funds

The scholarship is funded by donations and the College of Nursing and Health Sciences, Flinders University.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

- be Australian citizens or permanent residents of Australia; and
- have applied for admission to, or be enrolled in, the Graduate Certificate in Older Adult Care and Wellbeing.
- be able to demonstrate financial hardship; and
- be able to demonstrate active involvement in the delivery of care to the older person.

Tenure

One scholarship valued at \$1,000 will be available to be awarded annually to students enrolled on either a full-time or part-time basis, subject to the scholarship holder maintaining their enrolment, and satisfactory academic performance.

Selection

Selection will be made by a committee, comprising of representatives from the College of Nursing and Health Sciences. The scholarship will be awarded based on demonstrated financial need and demonstrated active involvement in the delivery of care to the older person.

Applications

Applications should be submitted online through the Student Management System.

The scholarship will be advertised on the University website and other appropriate media as determined by Flinders University.
