Step 1 - Select a Course

Search for the Extension Studies Program by typing **EXSP** in the search box, press Enter and scroll down through the options until you find Course First Half Year, Bedford Park (Load Category = Part Time). Liability Category will state 'Non Award' for domestic students and 'Intl Onshore' for International students.

You will be able to list your preferred delivery mode / location when nominating your preferred topic/s in Step 3.

Step 3 - Requirements

The requirements are split into five sections and you'll need to enter details into each of those by clicking on **RESPOND** button in each section.

When you have answered all the questions within a section, please make sure to click on **SAVE** before proceeding to the next section.

- Citizenship Status
 - Please provide details of your citizenship status
- Your School and Study
 - Enter your school details, year level, completed and planned study (Stage 1 and 2)
 - Attach your SACE Record of Achievement or your two most recent school reports
- Proposed University Study
 - Please select how many topics you wish to undertake (one or two) one successfully completed topic equates to 10 SACE credits and students may claim a maximum of 20 credits (two topics) as 'University Studies' towards the SACE.
 - Then you'll need to enter the details for each topic you wish to undertake. These details are available on the topic list which can be accessed at <u>flinders.edu.au/extension</u>
 - For topic code, enter as shown on topic list (e.g. BUSN1001)
 - If you have selected online, for campus location please also type online
 - Please make sure to check the list of topics before completing this section to ensure the topic availability (e.g. semester, delivery mode, location) matches the details on your application


If you haven't already done this you'll need to activate your FAN: <u>https://activate.flinders.edu.au/main</u>
